FIELD ARCHERY CLUB

CONSTITUTION 2022

1. The name of the club shall be CLOTH OF GOLD.
2. The aims of the club are to promote field archery and arrange functions designed to serve that intention.
3. The club shall be non-political and non-sectarian.
4. Shooting shall be conducted in accordance with the rules of shooting set out by the National Field Archery Society and as they may, from time to time, be amended by that body.
5. We comply with the Child and Vulnerable Adult Protection Policy of the NFAS.
6. Membership shall be open to all persons who:
 - a. Are members of the National Field Archery Society.
 - b. Are willing to abide by this constitution, and club rules.
 - c. Have paid a current club membership fee, which shall be decided annually at the Annual General Meeting.
 - d. Have attended an officially recognised training course and/or probation period, to be able to demonstrate safety and competence as an archer, and have been approved by the Club Sign Off Authority.
7. The financial year shall be from January to December and the Treasurer shall report the finances to the club membership at the end of the year, and at the Annual General Meeting.
8. Meetings:
 - a. The Annual General Meeting of the club shall be held in the subsequent financial year.
 - b. The Chairperson and Secretary jointly may convene such other General Meetings as are considered necessary.
 - c. The quorum for all General Meetings (including the Annual General Meeting) shall be six members, one of which must be an executive committee member and any one other officer of the club.
9. Management and control of the club shall be carried out by the three executive committee members, and all actions taken are to be in the club's interest. Any changes and or decisions made are to be advised to the club at the soonest club meeting available.

This does not take away the rights of the members to participate in the club's wellbeing.

This section of the constitution complies with the club's majority voted wishes at the 2022 EGM.

10. Officers shall be elected annually at the Annual General Meeting and shall be:
Chairperson, Secretary, Treasurer, Shoot Organiser, Course Officer (s) up to 4,
11. In the event that the club shall be dissolved the net cash and assets (after deductions of outstanding liabilities and dissolution costs) shall be disposed of in the manner decided by the members at the time of dissolution.
12. This Constitution shall only be revised or amended at a General Meeting after the members have been advised in writing of the proposed amendment (s) at least one week prior to the General Meeting concerned, and any such amendment (s) be carried by at least TWO THIRDS of the members present.
