It was good to see new faces on the podium, as well as welcome familiar ones back.

All NFAS bow classes were represented with the exception of Compound Limited (CL) and this shoot had a strong showing from Longbows (LB) and Thumb Draw (TD). It's always interesting to see with changing times and rules what class of bow archers want to shoot and how the different bows and shooting styles deal with the course. As hosts, we love nothing more than seeing smiling faces come back from a good days shooting and anticipate the positive comments we get from our visitors:
